These come in eight colors (two of which are plaid, which we love for a traditional look), and include a flat sheet, fitted sheet and coordinating pillowcases. If you're ready to dress your bed from head to toe (or pillowcase to duvet) your best bet is to spring for a sheet bundle. More than just sheets and pillowcases, this deluxe set also includes a duvet cover at a super reasonable price. And this update version from Parachute also includes an extra bottom sheet and pillowcase set so you'll always have clean ones in rotation. Plus, you can easily throw these in the washer and dryer without having to worry about treating them too delicately or having to iron them. The only thing to note is that these don't come with a top sheet, but many people don't prefer them anyway. You can always purchase one separately! If you're a hot sleeper, you're not alone. Waking up in the middle of the night to damp sheets thanks to overheating is no fun, and of course, means you're having to wash sheets more often which is equally un-fun. So what's the solution? Opt for sheets that are cooling, moisture-wicking, and that will have you feeling like your entire body is nestled on the cool side of the pillow. With twenty-five color options to choose from and a super-affordable price tag, it would be hard to not register for these. Even if you're not a hot sleeper, you can't go wrong with these! Oh, and they've got a 1500 thread-count so they feel super luxe. If you're looking to invest in really, really good quality linen sheets, we suggest these beauties. These are made start to finish with care, the linen sourced from mills in Italy and Belgium, and the sheets constructed in Westchester County, New York. When you buy one of these sheet sets you're also given lots of options: you can choose a flat and top sheet or two flat sheets (for those of you who don't believe in top sheets), and then either two pillowcases or two square shams. If that wasn't enough choice for you, there are twenty-five color options (one of which is a fun denim-y blue tri-colored stripe)—buy two sets and mix and match to your heart's desire! People love percale sheets for a myriad of reasons—it's a cotton weave that makes sheets feel breathable and smooth, but also have a crisp, polished look. They're a classic, reliable standby and the sheets you'll find yourself reaching for again and again. These percale sheets are made of Egyptian cotton and boast a 500 thread-count. They come in five essential colors, like Timeless Blush and Ash Grey (which coincidentally would look good mixed and matched together), and of course, there's a reason why cotton sheets are so popular. These sheets not only fit beds perfectly, regardless of mattress toppers (thanks to the generous sizing) but also feel like sleeping on the most luxe hotel sheets for half the price. Sign us up! If you love any of Casper's other products—we sometimes think of them as the OG of the mattress-in-a-box—you'll be happy to hear they have sheets—and they're good. These sateen sheets aren't super shiny (in case hearing sateen makes you think satin which makes you think slippery, anti-chic, and cheesy bedding of the '80s and '90s), and get softer and softer with every wash. These sheets are made from 100% organic cotton from Portugal and come with a fitted and flat sheet along with two pillowcases. As for color options, there are four to choose from and we're all about this pretty shade of lilac. Purple isn't a color that's easily done right, but Casper did it! We almost consider this shade as neutral and think it would look dreamy (pun intended) next to a dramatic, deep raspberry. These sheets will hands down make your bed your favorite place in your home. The finish is "heathered cashmere", meaning it has a soft, muted look thanks to the weave. The fibers are the perfect marriage of materials, combining the softness of cashmere with the breathability of the cotton. It's a win-win if you ask us. Plus—these sheets have the added bonus of getting softer with every wash and hold up well with lots of washes (you won't get sick of sleeping in these any time soon. These come in three beautiful colors—we're partial to the Frosted Blue. Courtesy of Hawkins New York Linen is the definitive luxury sheet for those who love a more laid-back, wabi-sabi look in their home. It's also a naturally moisture-wicking material, meaning that it will keep you feeling cool in the summer or if you happen to run hot while you sleep. This brand is known for its modern tableware and rustic, textured linens, so it's no surprise that their bedding would be stunning. Choose from 17 gorgeously muted colorways, including sky, terra cotta, and sage. Our advice—buy two sets and mix and match to your heart's desire! Bamboo regenerates naturally without chemicals, keeps the air and soil clean, and is an all-around good choice in the sustainability department. If that wasn't enough, bamboo sheets won't pill, are stain-resistant, and are incredibly cooling. This affordable set is crafted out of viscose made from 100% bamboo boasts a much softer feel than most 1,000 thread-count Egyptian cotton varieties. "The best sheet set is one that you look forward to getting into at the end of the day," says Ariel Kaye, the founder and CEO of Parachute. "Overall, when choosing bedding, I recommend looking for sheets that feature all-natural fibers." All-natural fibers like linen and cotton tend to be more durable and long-lasting. "Thread count is largely a marketing gimmick," says Kaye. "What actually matters more than thread count is the caliber of the fabric. We like to use long-staple Egyptian cotton and pure linen, which translates to softer, stronger bedding that lasts over time." If you're trying to understand thread count numbers on a package, remember that higher numbers usually translate to softer fabric. There are many other factors to consider, however, including the type of cotton, weave, and ply. When looking for new bedding, it's important to think about how you sleep—hot, cold, or somewhere in between? This can sometimes be tricky when selecting sheets with a partner, so a classic blend like percale, linen, or matte sateen can be a good middle ground. The texture is also important to consider. For example, Kaye refers to percale as "the perfect button-down shirt—cool and crisp to the touch." In contrast, satin is very smooth, lustrous, and naturally wrinkle-resistant. "Our Percale and Sateen are both made of cotton, but the difference is a result of how they're woven," says Kaye. The oil-free formula works great on all skin types, though it does have a mattifying and anti-shine effect that those with oily complexions will definitely appreciate. Still, the microfine mist is lightweight and breathable and sets makeup in place for up to 16 hours. There are plenty of setting sprays to be found at the drugstore, but this one takes first place in our book. Dermatologist- and allergy-tested, it's a good fit even for sensitive skin and offers a subtle mattifying effect that lasts all day. And of course, in true drugstore fashion, it's super affordable. To achieve that gorgeous, lit-from-within glow everyone and their mother wants, sure, you could load on highlighter galore...or you could just use a quick spritz of this guy. Made with over 20% botanical oils and humectants, it attracts plenty of moisture to your skin to leave it dewy and radiant. Mist it over a foundation that might otherwise read as matte or flat for instant luminosity. The formula also prevents caking. There's a good reason why this has been a staple in the kits of pro makeup artists' kits for years. It sets makeup and improves wear for 12 hours, and delivers an immediate dose of hydration, as well as skin-soothing green tea, cucumber, and chamomile. Not to mention that it's also dermatologist- and ophthalmologist-tested, and non-acnegenic, too. We heart products that make SPF reapplication easy, and this formula definitely falls into that category. The fine mist aerosol sets makeup and reduces shine, hydrates with hyaluronic acid, and even contains silicone powders that create a subtle blurring effect to make skin look that much better. And indeed, you get a dose of SPF 50 to boot. Part setting spray, part hydrating mist, part toner, this spritz is particularly great for dry skin. The bi-phase formula contains moringa seed oil in the first phase and clarifying witch hazel plus moisturizing aloe and electrolytes in the second. (Be sure to give the bottle a good shake before using to combine the two.) Spray it on to set your makeup, but it's also worth keeping on hand to use mid-day, or whenever your skin feels dry and needs a little pick-me-up. This comes in both a small and large size, ringing in at just a few bucks respectively, a true steal of a deal. Even more so given how effective the formula is at setting makeup, while also nourishing skin with aloe, green tea, cucumber, and vitamins A, C, and E. Try spraying a little onto your eyeshadow brush before applying shadow to help set it in place and prevent creasing. While not a setting spray in the traditional sense, this does work great to revive and refresh makeup, eliminating the need for touch-ups (hence its appearance on this list). You can also use it pre-makeup to hydrate and prep skin, and even during application to help all your products blend seamlessly. Also nice: It comes in a mini travel size that's great to take on-the-go. Beauty Bakerie is known for its long-lasting liquid lipsticks (Beyoncé is a fan—enough said), but its setting spray is not to be missed either. Like all the brand's creations, this product has a yummy scent (in this case, vanilla), but it also really works. Infused with aloe and ginger extracts, it's a 360-degree ultra-fine mist that smooths the skin while holding makeup in place. Plus, it actually doubles as a primer, so you can use it at both ends of your daily routine. You'll only find plant-based oils and extracts in this squeaky clean formula, which not only sets makeup but also hydrates and offers a hefty dose of protective antioxidants (thanks to all those natural ingredients). The scent is also addicting, a floral mix of jasmine, neroli, and rose...that's naturally-derived, obviously. Yes, it's another Urban Decay repeat; the brand really knows setting sprays. Reach for this one on those hot summer days when you can basically feel the makeup sliding off your face as soon as you leave the house. It boasts a unique temperature control technology that actually chills your makeup to set it in place for up to 12 hours, not to mention feels gloriously refreshing going on. #science. An alcohol-free formula is pretty much a must if you have dry and/or sensitive skin, which is why we like this one.
